Comments from those in opposition

We live directly opposite the play area on Addison Drive and I have never noticed any dropped litter in the 4 years that we have lived here. Residents themselves have scrubbed graffiti from the play equipment after an incident of vandalism and generally watch over the area. In my opinion, a litter bin would be an unnecessary outlay.

It will encourage over-use, spillage, wasps, rats etc – there have been no problems to date (5 years) – items collected by local residents.

If there is a bin, judging by some other sites on Trinity Mead, they are not emptied regularly so overflow onto the floor. I would support it is guaranteed to be emptied every day/other day. People live locally to the park, I'm sure it is not a great effort to take litter home.
